## Offense Against City Regulations

### *GENERAL PROVISIONS*

#### **§ 130.01 EXPECTORATING IN PUBLIC PLACES.**

No person shall expectorate in any public place, except into a receptacle provided for that purpose. ('69 Code, § 6203.1) Penalty, see § 10.99

#### **§ 130.02 PUBLIC RESTROOMS.**

No person owning, in charge of, or in control of any lavatory or washroom for use of the public shall provide in or about such lavatory or washroom any towel for common use. The term *COMMON USE* as used in this section shall mean use by more than one person without cleansing. ('69 Code, § 6203.2) Penalty, see § 10.99

#### **§ 130.03 UNLAWFUL DRAINAGE.**

No person shall spill or drain any waste or liquid waste of any kind upon the ground or upon any paved area. ('69 Code, § 6203.3) Penalty, see § 10.99

### *DISORDERLY CONDUCT*

#### **§ 130.15 CONDUCT.**

Any person who shall do any of the following acts in the city shall be guilty of disorderly conduct:

(A) Incite, encourage, participate in any manner, or be connected with any row, riot, unlawful assemblage, or disorder, or make or assist in making any noise or disturbance which shall tend to destroy peace and good order.

(B) Disturb or be instrumental in disturbing any school, meeting, or congregation, lawfully assembled, whether religious, political or otherwise.

(C) Jostle or roughly crowd or push any person unnecessarily in any street, alley, or other public place.

- (D) Engage in any frays or commit any assault or assault and battery upon another or commit any act whatsoever amounting to a breach of the peace.
- (E) Be under the influence of intoxicating liquor or narcotic drugs upon any public street or in any public place.
- (F) Make any immoral or obscene exhibition or exposure of his or her person.
- (G) Engage in any indecent, insulting, immoral or obscene conduct in any public street, alley, or other place.
- (H) Utter any profanity, indecent, or improper language in any public street, alley, or other public place.
- (I) Publish, sell, offer for sale, give away, exhibit, or possess for such purpose any obscene, indecent, or immoral book, pamphlet, paper, picture, statuary, image, or representation.
- (J) Conduct, manage, or be connected with any indecent or obscene show or exhibition of any kind.
- (K) Engage in any window peeping.
- (L) Engage for hire in the practice or occupation of fortune telling, mind reading, or phrenology.
- (M) Spit on any street or sidewalk or on the floor or wall of any place of public assemblage.
- (N) Discharge any firearm or air gun.
- (O) Explode any fireworks or firecrackers except by written permission of the Mayor or City Clerk.
- (P) Maliciously or willfully destroy, deface, damage or injure any public property or any private property owned by another.
- (Q) Beg in any street, alley, or other public place.
- (R) Insult, accost, molest, or otherwise annoy either by word of mouth, or by sign or motion, any person in any street, alley, or other public place.
- (S) Misrepresent or falsify his or her age, or the age of another, for the purpose of obtaining beer, wine, liquor, or other intoxicating beverage for any minor under the age of 21 years.
- (T) Obstruct, resist, injure, or fail or refuse to comply with any lawful order or direction of a police officer. ('69 Code, § 4201.1) Penalty, see § 10.99

## Offense Against City Regulations

### *PROSTITUTION*

#### **§ 130.30 UNLAWFUL TO PRACTICE.**

No person shall engage in prostitution. ('69 Code, § 4202.1) Penalty, see § 10.99

#### **§ 130.31 HOUSE OF PROSTITUTION.**

No person shall consort in a house of ill fame or place where prostitution or lewdness is practiced, encouraged, or allowed. ('69 Code, § 4202.2) Penalty, see § 10.99

#### **§ 130.32 UNLAWFUL SEXUAL SOLICITATION.**

No person shall by physical motion, word, sign, or in any other manner solicit, urge, incite, compel, force, or require any other person to engage in illegal sexual intercourse. ('69 Code, § 4202.3) Penalty, see § 10.99

#### **§ 130.33 HARBORING OF PROSTITUTION.**

No person shall harbor or keep about his or her premises any prostitute or permit any prostitution therein. ('69 Code, § 4202.4) Penalty, see § 10.99

### *CURFEW*

#### **§130.45 REGULATION FOR MINORS.**

(A) No minor under the age of 15 years shall be abroad upon the public streets, alleys, parks, or other public places of the city, unless accompanied by a parent or guardian, relative, or adult person placed in charge of the minor by the parent or guardian, between the following hours:

- (1) Sunday through Thursday: Between 10:00 p.m. and 6.00 a.m.
- (2) Friday and Saturday: Between 11:00 p.m. and 6:00 a.m.

(B) *Exemptions.* This section does not apply to a minor who is:

- (1) Accompanied by the minor's parent or guardian;
- (2) On an errand at the direction of the minor's parent or guardian, without any detour or stop;
- (3) In a motor vehicle involved in interstate travel;
- (4) Engaged in an employment activity, or going to or returning home from an employment activity, without any detour or stop;
- (5) Involved in an emergency;
- (6) On the sidewalk abutting the minor's residence or the residence of a next-door neighbor if the neighbor did not complain to the police department about the minor's presence;
- (7) Attending a lawful school, religious, or other recreational activity supervised by adults, or going to or returning home from, without any detour or stop, a lawful school, religious, or other recreational activity supervised by adults;
- (8) Exercising First Amendment rights protected by the United States Constitution, such as the free exercise of religion, freedom of speech, and the right of assembly; or
- (9) Married or had been married or had disabilities of minority removed in accordance with state law.

### **§ 130.46 PROSECUTION OF PARENT OR GUARDIAN.**

It shall be unlawful for either or both of the parents, or the guardian or adult person placed in charge of any minor under the age of 15 years, to permit, allow, or suffer the minor to violate the provisions of § 130.45 of this chapter. ('69 Code/ § 4402.1) Penalty, see § 10.99

### *CIVIL DEFENSE EMERGENCY*

### **§ 130.55 DISOBEYING REGULATIONS AND AUTHORITIES.**

No person shall violate or disobey any duly promulgated regulation or order during a civil defense emergency or duly authorized civil defense test or drill or disobey any official order by any duly authorized person concerning the conduct of civilians, the movement and cessation of pedestrian and vehicular traffic or the taking of shelter in designated shelter areas. ('69 Code, § 3212.1) Penalty, see § 10.99
