A RESOLUTION OF INTENT TO INITIATE ENROLLMENT FOR RAYMOND VASSER, CITY SUPERINTENDENT AND DDA DIRECTOR, AND ROBERT VAUTAW, CITY ADMINISTRATOR, INTO THE MUNICIPAL EMPLOYEES' RETIREMENT SYSTEM (MERS) OF MICHIGAN, AT THE CITY'S DISCRETION THE 401A/457 PLANS WILL BE OPTIONS, AND FURTHER THERE WILL BE AN EIGHT PERCENT EMPLOYER MATCH, WHICH WILL BE PAID RETROACTIVELY FOR THE CURRENT FISCAL YEAR (APRIL 1, 2022).
