MAPLE GROVE PARK RULES

IT SHALL BE UNLAWFUL

1. To remove, destroy or mutilate City Park property or equipment.
2. To destroy, damage or deface any tree or other vegetation: including pounding nails or any type of fastener to same.
3. To allow any animal to run or walk in park. Animals must remain on renter's lot on a leash under six feet in length and under control. To allow animals to run free- they must be leashed at all times.
4. To allow continuous barking or noise making of animals night or day.
5. For renters to neglect to pick up and dispose of their animals waste.
6. To camp without a written permit. Permit to be posted on site.
7. To advertise any item for sale on City Park Property.
8. To operate any vehicle except on Park roads.
9. To operate any vehicle on any Park road at a speed greater than 15 MPH or greater than the posted speed.
10. To operate any vehicle contrary to Michigan Motor Vehicle code.
11. To use loud speakers or amplifying device.
12. To make excessive noise after 10 p.m. (Loud talking, singing, music, etc.) and before 8 a.m.
13. To allow visitors after 10 p.m. and before 8 a.m.
14. To have campfires anywhere except in areas as provided.
15. To leave refuse and rubbish, including tin cans or bottles any place except in designated containers provided by the park.
16. To use or possess intoxicating beverages.
17. To sublet any RV unit.
18. To park, cruise, party or picnic after 10 p.m. or before 8 a.m. in any area of the park.
19. To use more than one table provided by the park for each trailer or camp site.
20. To change position of RV unit or camp site without written permission.
21. To have more than one unit per lot (1 trailer, 1 camper, 1 tent, etc.) – shall not be permitted without permission from park host.
22. To disobey lawful order of park host.
23. To use fireworks that leave the ground anywhere in the park or open field on east side of park.

YOU MUST.....

1. Fill out registration card including number in party.
2. Comply with check-out time of 12:00 p.m.
3. Comply with the park closing from 10:00 p.m. to 8:00 a.m.; No unauthorized person(s) shall be on park property.

Reservations for next year can only be made on or after April 1st of the next year. You can call 231-839-4429 or if no answer, call the office at 231-839-4561. (If the 1st falls on weekend, reservations will be taken on the Monday after.)

You can reserve a camp site in the camp but not a specific site number. Unreserved sites are available on a first come first serve basis. If the site number you want is available when you arrive then you can take it. We will not make anyone move.
